- 9. In this project I will be required to practice on a memory board game for 20 minutes per day, for a period of four weeks (20 training days). I will be randomly allocated to practice on either the smell-based or visual based memory board game. I will also be required to record my training sessions and performance in activity logbooks. I will be involved in three face-to-face assessments which will include an evaluation of my thinking abilities (including memory), as well as my sense of smell through tests and questionnaires that measure these abilities.
- 10. I understand that my participation is voluntary and that I am free to withdraw from this project anytime without explanation or prejudice and to withdraw any unprocessed data that I have provided.
- 11. I understand that the physical data from this research will be stored at Deakin University for 15 years, after which it will be destroyed. Digital data collected from
