**Resolution No. 3/2019
of the University Bioethics Committee for Scientific Research at the Jerzy Kukuczka Academy of
Physical Education in Katowice
dated January 17, 2019
regarding the opinion on a medical experiment project**

Acting on the basis of § 6(5) of the Regulation of the Minister of Health and Social Assistance on the detailed guidelines for the appointment, financing and mode of operation of bioethics committees dated 11.05.1999. (Journal of Laws 1999 No. 47, item 480) the following is established:

§1

The University Bioethics Committee for Scientific Research at the Jerzy Kukuczka Academy of Physical Education in Katowice, after analysing the application submitted by Andrzej Myśliwiec, Ph. D., Associate Professor, regarding: "The study on the development of an interactive spinal and body posture rehabilitation system in the context of dynamic, personalised Disk4Spine stimulation," and after hearing additional information, holding a discussion and a vote,

has adopted a resolution to positively assess the application.

§2

This opinion pertains solely to the application considered in relation to the project presented; any change or modification requires obtaining a separate opinion. The Applicant is obliged to inform [the Committee] about any amendments that could affect the opinions of the Committee, about serious or unexpected adverse events and unforeseen circumstances, and decisions of other bioethics committees.

§3

The Commission expects a report on the study [results] after its completion.
