Conditions of Approval:

Research projects are normally approved to the anniversary date of the approval. Projects may be renewed yearly for up to a total of three years upon receipt of a satisfactory annual report. If a project is to continue beyond three years, two optional extensions of one year each (3+1+1) will need to be applied for. Anything beyond 5 years will need a new application to be submitted.

Please note that the following conditions apply to your approval. Failure to abide by these conditions may result in suspension or discontinuation of approval and/or disciplinary action.

- 1. Limit of Approval: Approval is limited strictly to the research as submitted in your Project application.
- Variation to Project: Any subsequent variations or modifications you might wish to make to the Project must be notified formally to the Committee for further
 consideration and approval. If the Committee considers that the proposed changes are significant, you may be required to submit a new application for approval
 of the revised Project.
- 3. **Incidents or adverse effects:** Researchers must report immediately to the Committee anything which might affect the ethical acceptance of the protocol including adverse effects on participants or unforeseen events that might affect continued ethical acceptability of the Project. Failure to do so may result in suspension or cancellation of approval.
- 4. **Monitoring:** All projects are subject to monitoring at any time by the Committee.
- 5. **Annual Report:** Please be aware that the Committee requires that researchers submit an annual report on each of their projects at the end of the year, or at the conclusion of a project if it continues for less than this time. Failure to submit an annual report will mean that ethics approval will lapse.
- 6. Auditing: All projects may be subject to audit by members of the Committee.
