Thank you for submitting the above research project for single ethical review. This project was received by the Royal Brisbane & Women's Hospital Human Research Ethics Committee (RBWH HREC) (EC00172) on 21 May 2021 and was reviewed by a sub-Committee of the HREC. The research project meets the requirements of the National Health and Medical Research Council's (NHMRC) *National Statement on Ethical Conduct in Human Research (2007)*.

- b. Serious Adverse Events that materially impact on the continued ethical acceptability of the project.
- 3. Amendments to the research project are to be submitted to the HREC for review. Amendments should be reflected in a cover letter from the Principal Investigator, providing a description of the changes, the rationale for the changes, and their implications for the ongoing conduct of the study.
