### What is the investigational nature of this Research?

This study is a randomized controlled trial which entails participants being randomly allocated to one of two groups, each listening to a different soundtrack. Participants will answer questionnaires before and after listening to the soundtrack.

The purpose of this Research is to investigate the effects of Chinese instrumental music on the psychological and physical well-being of older adults.

#### Why have I been invited to take part in this Research?

You have been invited to participate in this study because you meet our inclusion criteria of being (1) 60 years old and above with (2) chronic pain for more than 3 months. You also do not meet our exclusion criteria which are having: (1) cognitive impairment (AMT  $\leq$  6), (2) profound hearing loss, (3) official diagnosis of mental disorders, (4) acute injuries in the past 3 months, and (5) unable to understand/converse in English, Mandarin and/or Chinese dialects.

- (3) You will be listening to the soundtrack through headphones attached to the computer provided while seated. The soundtrack will last for approximately 30 minutes, and you will be requested to refrain from doing anything else (e.g., Talking to others) during these 30 minutes.
- (4) You will be requested to answer an online questionnaire on the computer provided after listening to the soundtrack.

There are no follow-up sessions.
